


Charles and Oliver are looking for food

Find these hidden foods in the picture below.






Read Chapter Two. Then draw a line to show where Charles and Oliver went.








Look carefully at these unusual shadows. Then draw a line from each shadow to all the objects that could be combined to make that shadow. The first one is done for you.








Charles and Oliver are looking for the Queen's treasure. Help them find their way through the maze to the bottom of the sea.

You can learn how bell diving works, just like Charles and Oliver did.


1. Fill a sink or large bowl with water.



 Take an empty glass in one hand and a dry cotton ball in the other.




3. Tip the glass upside down and hold the cotton ball inside. Then dip it all under the water.
The cotton will stay dry!






Read Chapter Six. Then write each ship's name on the line near it and finish each flag. (HINT: notice which ship has cannons.)






Put a number above each picture to show where it goes on the ship.






Did you get everything in the right place? Now draw some pirate sea dogs onboard the ship.




This ship is sinking!
