### Developing Bible Study Skills

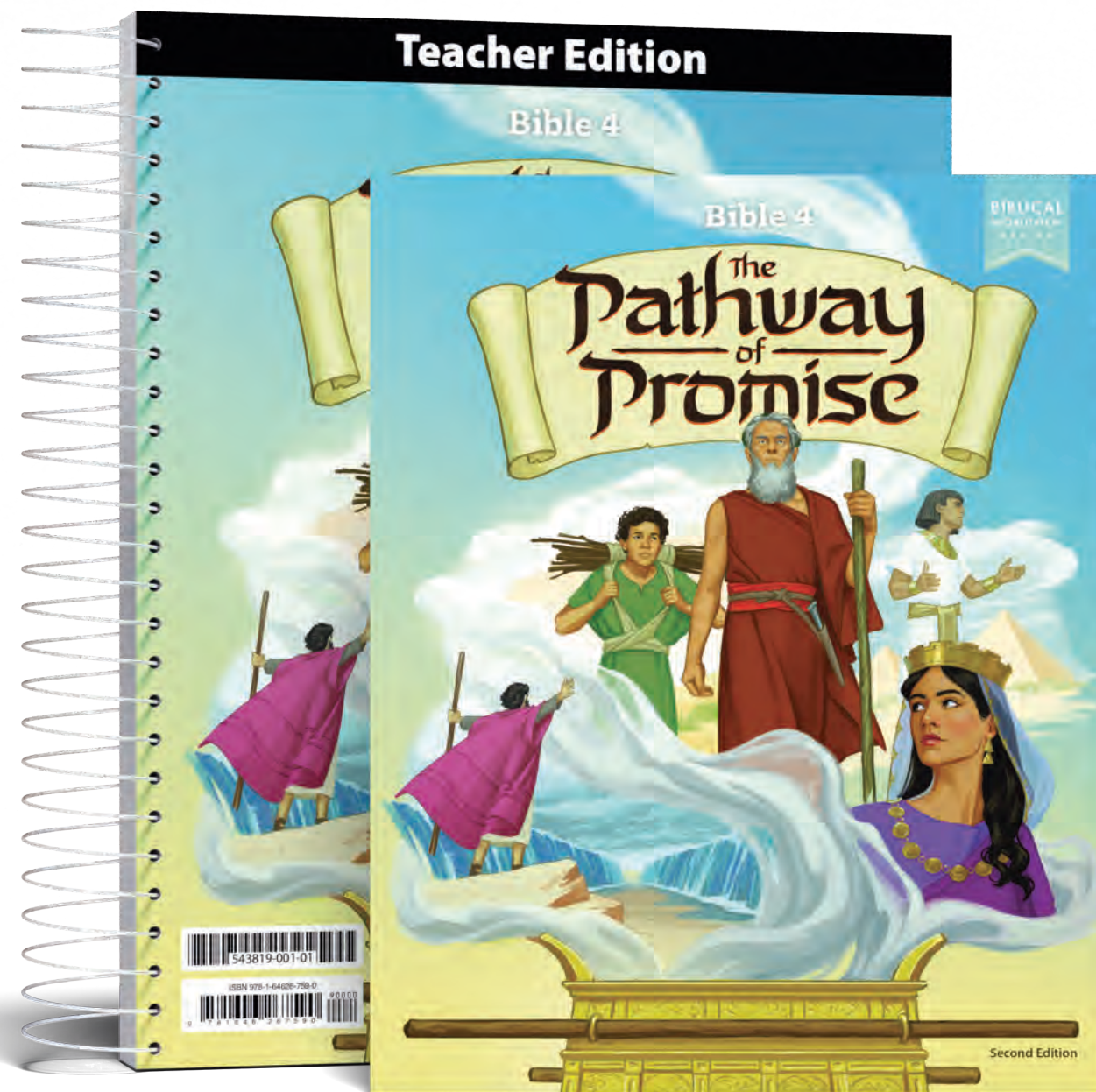

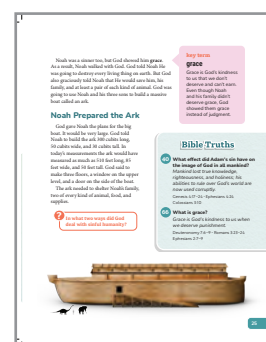
### Engaging New Format

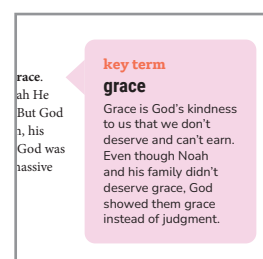

## Materials

### Student Edition

The Student Edition uses vivid illustrations, age-appropriate content, and engaging activities to guide students through God's unified story in the Old Testament. Each lesson includes a key question to highlight major themes and encourage personal reflection. Students are led to explore Scripture closely and apply its truths to daily life, growing in understanding, love for God, and a desire to serve Him.

### Teacher Edition

The Teacher Edition provides a clear, goal-focused plan for teaching Bible 4 to students through a variety of instructional strategies, including discussion, role-playing, and cooperative learning. Built around an effective teaching cycle, it incorporates differentiated instruction activities and expanded technology resources to meet different learning needs. Each approach is designed to help students connect biblical truth to their own lives, ultimately guiding them to internalize and live out God's Word.

### Activities

The Activities Book reinforces the Student Edition through engaging, hands-on activities that deepen student understanding and application. Each activity is designed to support key biblical themes while promoting active learning. The Think Like a Bible Sleuth! feature continues in the Activities Book, encouraging students to dig into Scripture, think critically, and respond with both heart and mind to God's Word.
