Confucianism identifies five basic human relationships, but it leaves out the most important relationship of all—man and God.2. Confucianism teaches that people simply need to choose to act rightly in every relationship and assumes that people are basically good. The Bible teaches that since unsaved people are slaves to sin, they are unable to simply choose to do right.3. Confucianism is man-centered and relies on man's effort to achieve human goals. It does not teach that there is a divine being. Christians know that God exists and that sinful man has to depend on God's grace for salvation.4. Confucianism teaches that children must fulfill their parents' wishes, even if those wishes are wrong. Christ said that loyalty to Him may demand sacrificing loyalty to family.
